255 illustrates both the 'arbitrary' line and how infeasible it is to put a fence there.

Much thought went into the design and construction of this garden, and all laws and park rules were considered. Thank you for considering a resolve on this dispute, regardless of other issues. Please let us know at your earliest convenience if we may replace our netting, even without the additional four feet in the back corner. If you would like any current photos of the current state of these spaces, feel free ask. I do have video footage of my neighbors taunting me and damaging my property as they destroyed all the work I'd put into that fence, as well as photos of the damage the deer have done, and I am reserving these until I have consulted with an attorney. While we have not reached an agreement satisfactory to the both of us, I appreciate your willingness to consider the facts and I still hope for an amiable solution.
